Newton Abbot Community Transport

Newton Abbot Community Transport is a charity that provides a range of transport options for people wanting to get out and about in Newton Abbot and surrounding areas. Their service is mainly run by volunteers, and they aim to keep their fares and fees as low as possible, with funds re-invested in the charity.

Services Available:

- Wheelchair accessible vehicles from six to sixteen passenger seats
- Ring & Ride door to door transport
- Shopmobility scooter, wheelchair and walker hire
- Local scheduled bus services
- Daily living aids sales and advice (DCC/NHS approved)

Ring & Ride

Local people who have difficulty walking or have no local bus service may be able to use Ring & Ride to get into and around Newton Abbot. The wheelchair friendly minibuses can collect you from your home and take you to various places in town, including Shopmobility, returning after about two hours. Drivers can help you on and off the buses and assist with shopping bags, trolleys, walkers and pushchairs.

Different areas are covered different days of the week and include Newton Abbot, Ashburton, Bovey Tracey and outlying villages.
