Worried about a child's safety? (Devon area)

If you are concerned about the safety of a child in Devon or want to speak to someone, or if you are a child worried about your own safety, contact the Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub (MASH) by completing the support form available on the website **devoncountycouncil.outsystemsenterprise.com/MASH/homepage**, call **0345 155 1071** or email **mashsecure@devon.gov.uk** and give as much information as you can. If a child is at immediate risk, contact the police on **999**.
